To develop students' academic writing and research skills, including topic selection, literature review, data analysis, and proper citation practices. 3. To guide students on the process of preparing a research paper, including collecting the reference papers from various indexing sites such as ieeexplore, sciencedirect, springerlink and wiley online library.
